

SMELL NATURAL GAS? GET OUT FAST. CALL 911.

Use all your senses to stay alert
to the signs of a natural gas leak.



LOOK

Natural gas leaks will sometimes cause bubbling water, blowing dirt or dead plants.



LISTEN

Natural gas leaks will sometimes cause a hissing sound near a natural gas line or meter.



SMELL

Natural gas smells like rotten eggs.

IF YOU SUSPECT A NATURAL GAS LEAK:

Leave the area immediately.

Call 911, or call Piedmont at 800.752.7504
(call from a neighbor's house or from
another location far from the smell of
natural gas).



- **DO NOT** use anything electrical that may create a spark; this includes cellphones



- **DO NOT** operate any light switches



- **DO NOT** light a match



- **DO NOT** attempt to locate the source of a leak



- **DO NOT** attempt to stop a leak



- **DO NOT** return to the area until the emergency services or Piedmont Natural Gas has declared the area safe

Piedmont Natural Gas does not maintain customers' natural gas piping after or downstream of the meter. You should maintain such piping by periodically inspecting for leaks. If the piping is metal, you should also check for signs of corrosion. You should repair such piping if corrosion or leaks are discovered. For assistance locating, inspecting or repairing buried piping, please contact Piedmont Natural Gas or a licensed heating/plumbing contractor. You should always call 811 prior to digging. Once your lines are marked, always dig by hand if digging near natural gas piping.
